





AUSTRIAN OPEN-AIR MUSEUM STÜBING

At the open-air museum in Stübing, you can wander through Austria from the Burgenland to Vorarlberg regions and get to know the building styles and way of life as well as typical regional tools from the past in idyllic surroundings. REIN ABBEY

The Rein Baroque monastery rises picturesquely about 20 km north of Graz. Cistercian monks have lived here continuously since 1129, making it the oldest Cistercian monastery still in existence in the world. The Baroque collegiate church radiates sublime beauty, the library contains medieval manuscripts from the monastery's own writing room and the extensive monastery forests invite you to take walks and hikes. SENSENWERK DEUTSCHFEISTRITZ SCYTHE FACTORY



Before combine harvesters and sickle mowers made the work of farmers much easier, the scythe was one of the most important tools in agriculture. The entire production plant with its six huge water wheels has been preserved as a museum in the former scythe factory. The premises also provide an exciting setting for theatre performances, concerts and art exhibitions.

MARIA STRASSENGEL PILGRIMAGE CHURCH

The small church settlement of Maria Straßengel rises on a hill, visible from afar, just a few kilometres north of Graz. A defensive wall encloses the presbytery, the tavern, the Baroque "new building" and the pilgrimage church, which is one of the most important high gothic sacred buildings in Austria with its tower. By the way: a varied hike with wonderful viewpoints leads from the Gösting castle ruins in Graz to Maria Straßengel. LURGROTTE CAVE IN PEGGAU & SEMRIACH



The Lurgrotte is the largest water-flowing stalactite cave in Austria. For millions of years, surface water has been penetrating the grotto, which the Lurbach stream has eroded into the limestone rock, depositing lime constantly and forming impressive fragile and powerful works of art. You can dive into this fascinating cave world from Peggau or Semriach.

Light and sound experience in the Lurgrotte Semriach

A light show lets the largest stalactite in the world shine in a completely new light. The special light effects reveal a true cosmos of shapes and colours, which remained hidden until not so long ago.

Prehistoric Museum

The Prehistoric Museum has been located in the Lurgrotte in Peggau since 2019. When you enter the Lurgrotte in Peggau on your journey into prehistory, you encounter the skeleton of a cave bear, a mammoth's tusk and plants that apparently grow without daylight.




