


Dachstein Hiking Tour



Welcome!




The Dachstein and its surrounding regions attract hiking fans with one of the most beautiful extended hiking tours in the Alps, passing through Styria, Upper Austria and Salzburg. In 1997, the Dachstein, together with the Dachstein Salzkammergut Region, was added to UNESCO's World Natural and Cultural Heritage Lists. Along the path, you will learn much about local history, gaining interesting insights into the region's past and future, as well as prominent personalities associated with the famous mountain massif.

During your tour around the Dachstein, you will mostly be in high-alpine terrain. Which means that mountaineering gear as well as stamina are a must. Necessities include: mountain shoes, functional clothing, backpack, water and food, protection against the rain and sun, a first-aid kit, mobile phone, possibly hiking poles,... rock-climbing equipment and other specialized paraphernalia are not required. The paths are clearly signposted, though markings may be covered by snow on occasion. That said, you should always carry maps as well as the Dachstein Hiking Booklet with you.



Overview of the 8 Stages



1 *Gosausee – Hofpürglhütte*
on the Austraweg, past the Stuhlalm to the Hofpürglhütte below the Bischofsmütze

2 *Hofpürglhütte – Dachstein-Südwandhütte*
via the Linzerweg through the Rinderfeld to the Sulzenschneid, with fantastic views of the Dachstein massif, continuing through the "Tor" and dominated by the south face of the Dachstein

3 *Dachstein-Südwandhütte – Hunerkogel – Guttenberghaus*
high elevations including a glacier hike and the rugged landscapes »am Stein«

4 *Guttenberghaus – Stoderzinken*
across the alpine pastures »am Stein« to the scenic summit of the Stoderzinken

5 *Stoderzinken – Bad Mitterndorf*
via the Notgasse, Viehbergalm and remote summits to the Steinitzenalm or Bad Mitterndorf

6 *Bad Mitterndorf – Hallstatt*
flat paths alongside the stream: moors, karst springs, tranquil forest lakes and the Salzkammerweg path leading to Hallstatt

7 *Hallstatt – Bad Goisern*
along the eastern shore of Lake Hallstatt and over a footbridge to Bad Goisern, through the UNESCO World Heritage Region


8 *Bad Goisern – Gosau*
on natural forest paths to the Goisererhütte and through alpine pastures to Gosau

5fingers on the Krippenstein

At 2100 m, you will be able to look far across the UNESCO World Heritage Region Hallstatt-Dachstein/Salzkammergut. As you enjoy the sight of the clear Hallstättersee and the alpine landscapes, a 400 m deep precipice will be right below your feet.



Gosausee

Influencers and travel bloggers have made it famous: the Lower Gosausee, a mountain lake embedded amid unique landscapes, with views of the majestic Dachstein and just a stone's throw from the Gosaukamm. A lake that is used as a source of energy, supplying power to numerous homes.

Bischofsmütze

The Bischofsmütze is the most striking peak in the area, with an intriguing story about those who were the first to conquer it. The mountain is a true source of inspiration and spiritual panacea.

View of the Grimming

The Grimming (2351 m) was thought to be the highest mountain in Styria for a long time. The high valley of Bad Mitterndorf at the foot of the Grimming extends from the Tauplitz to the Ödensee.

Stairway to Nothingness

In addition to the glass-sided panorama gondola that will carry you to 2700 m in just 10 minutes, and along with the great scenery, the glacier also boasts the "Sky Walk", "Ice Palace", a 100 m long suspension footbridge and the "Stairway to Nothingness".

Hallstatt

The Dachstein in the back, Obertraun, Hallstatt and Bad Goisern on either side and the River Traun between – Lake Hallstatt doesn't only represent one of the most striking landscapes in the Salzkammergut, it is also an authentic "lake personality" in its own right, with a truly mystical character on rainy days.

Peace Chapel on the Stoderzinken

Peace Chapel, which was built in 1902, rewards visitors with fantastic panoramas. This small memorial site has become an emblem that is admired and venerated far beyond the borders of Ennstal.

Ödensee

Ödensee is the center of a nature sanctuary. Various interactive information stations provide intriguing insights into the forest lake itself, the surrounding high moors and the karst springs.



Pure Enjoyment 3 nights

3 days of relaxed hiking through the alpine pastures of the eastern Dachstein mountains. Highlights: overnights at rustic huts and traditional hut meals. You will hike from the Stoderzinken near Gröbming to Bad Aussee.

Bed- or mattress dorms (no double or single rooms!).
Blankets provided at huts, only a lightweight »hut sleeping bag« made of cotton/silk is necessary. Opening times of some huts are restricted as of October!

Luggage Transport:

Between accommodations. For overnights at huts during hikes, you will need to carry necessities and a sleeping bag with you. Luggage cannot be transported to the Guttenberghaus, Hofpürgl- or Goisererhütte.
