Gorges

In Schladming-Dachstein

Donnersbachklamm

The path through this natural monument leads you through forests and meadows, up steps and across bridges. You will also encounter a woodcutters' hut, the reconstruction of a logging weir and the "Story Bench". Listen to Sigi's Gorge Tales (in German): anchor.fm/klammgeschichten

Silberkarklamm

Nature experience in the heart of the Dachstein massif. Via steps and wooden bridges, past rushing rapids, up to the Silberkarhütte. Physical challenge: A steep ascent over loose rock, reaching the Silberkarsee in around 1.5 hours. Three different fixed-cable climbs also await intrepid adventurers inside this gorge.

Talbachklamm

As the Talbach makes its way from Rohrmooser Ober- and Untertal into the mountain town of Schladming, a marvelous encounter with water awaits you. The gorge is also located on the "Wild Waters" theme path and is floodlit until midnight.

Wörschachklamm FORWARD ONLY

Wild, romantic, step-by-step past splashing waterfalls and bizarre rock formations. Viewing platforms allow you to marvel at what you see. At the far end of the gorge, you have diverse options: continue to the Spechtensee, the ruins of Castle Wolkenstein or perhaps to the Oberkogler-Alm?

Valley of a Thousand Springs

Schladming-Dachstein is rich. Rich in water. And this elixir of life is on display here in the widest variety of wonderful forms. 300 mountain lakes, 100 waterfalls and 1,000 springs make this region more abundant in water than anywhere else in Austria.

Alpine Trail "Durch die Höll"

Spectacular "Wild Waters". Steps, trails and a 50 meters-long suspension footbridge lead you to the Riesach Waterfall (the biggest in Styria), continuing to the Gfölleralm on the shore of the Riesachsee.

Klafferkessel Alpine Conquest

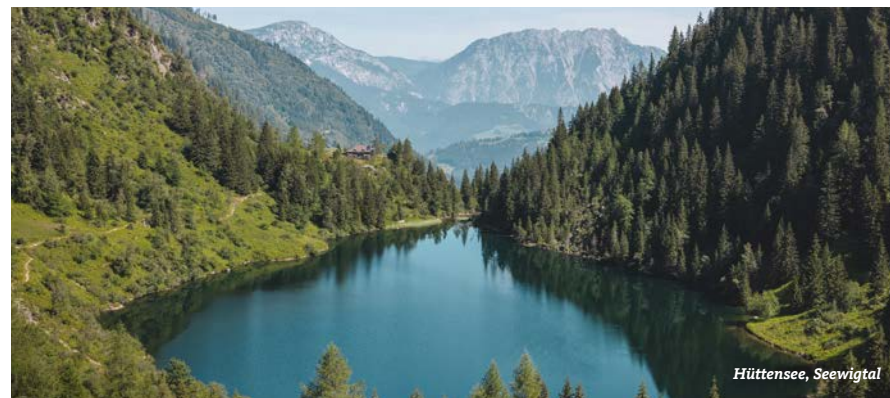
A summiting tour for hikers with stamina, leading to an elevation of 2,300 meters above sea level. 30 tarns of all sizes and shapes lie there idyllically before your eyes.

Valley of Plunging Waters

Three mountain lakes plus two waterfalls at different elevations. This hiking tour takes you from the Steirischer Bodensee to the Hüttensee and out as far as the Obersee.

Spiegelsee

The imposing immensity of the Dachstein massif is mirrored magically on the surface of this small mountain lake. 45 min from the Reiteralm.

Seekarlsee

Caribbean feeling at 2,140 m above sea level. Via the Tuchmoaralm, you will reach this turquoise tarn in about 3 ½ hours.

Stierkarsee

Next to the Sattentalbach, past the Stierkarsee and up to the Goldlacken, a collection of smaller tarns (3 h).

Spechtensee

Easy to reach. Lying right next to the Spechten-seehütte, a walk around this lake is impossible to resist.

Finsterkarsee

A destination that will bring joy to your heart. From the lift station at the Riesneralm to the Finsterkaralm, continuing to the lake (1.5 h).

Giglachseen

The starting point for your hike to the two Giglachseen lakes is the Ursprungalm. This area of glorious alpine pastures even served as the backdrop for a Heidi movie starring Charlie Sheen. Actual walking time: 1 h 20 min.

Miesbodensee

Hike through the fascinating Öfenschlucht canyon up to the Viehbergalm, enjoy a slice of fresh bread coated with aromatic Steirerkas, and continue to the Miesbodensee (2 h).

Plannersee

From the Pine Distillery, a 45 min hike will bring you to the Plannersee. Hiking tip: 2 more hours will bring you to the top of the highest mountain on the Planneralm: the Hochrettelstein.

Duisitzkarsee

A true natural jewel! In Obertal, reachable via the Eschachalm and a hiking trail in about 1 ½ h.

Schwarzensee

In Sölk-täler Nature Park, a leisurely hour-long walk (also possible with a pram) will bring you to this idyllic lake. Another 45 min and you will reach the Putzentalm hut where they serve hearty snacks and refreshing drinks.

Old Ruins & Ancient Walls

Wolkenstein Castle Ruins in Wörschach

Former seat of princely rule and justice in Ennstal. Mining began at the beginning of the 12th cent. – the remains of the walls give us a clear sense of what the original fortress looked like. Reachable in about 15 min via a hiking trail from the gorge car park.

Neuhaus Church Ruins in Trautenfels

Not far from Schloss Trautenfels (ca. 10 min walk), you will discover remnants of a Protestant house of worship from 1575, destroyed barely 24 years later during the Counter Reformation.

St. Giles’ Church in Donnersbach

On the toll-free mountain road leading up to the Planneralm, it is worth making a stop to see these church ruins. The walls which are still visible are from a Romanesque church from the first half of the 12th century.

Town Gate in Schladming

Next to the Catholic church stands the last remaining gate of the former town walls. Opposite the elementary school and in Berggasse, you will find remnants of the defensive wall which was expanded in 1629.

Glattjoch Chapel in Donnersbachwald

A roughly 3-hour hike will bring you to the highest sacred building in Styria at 1989 m above sea level. The corbel-vault construction is the only example of its kind in Central Europe, believed to have been constructed in the 9th – 10th century.
