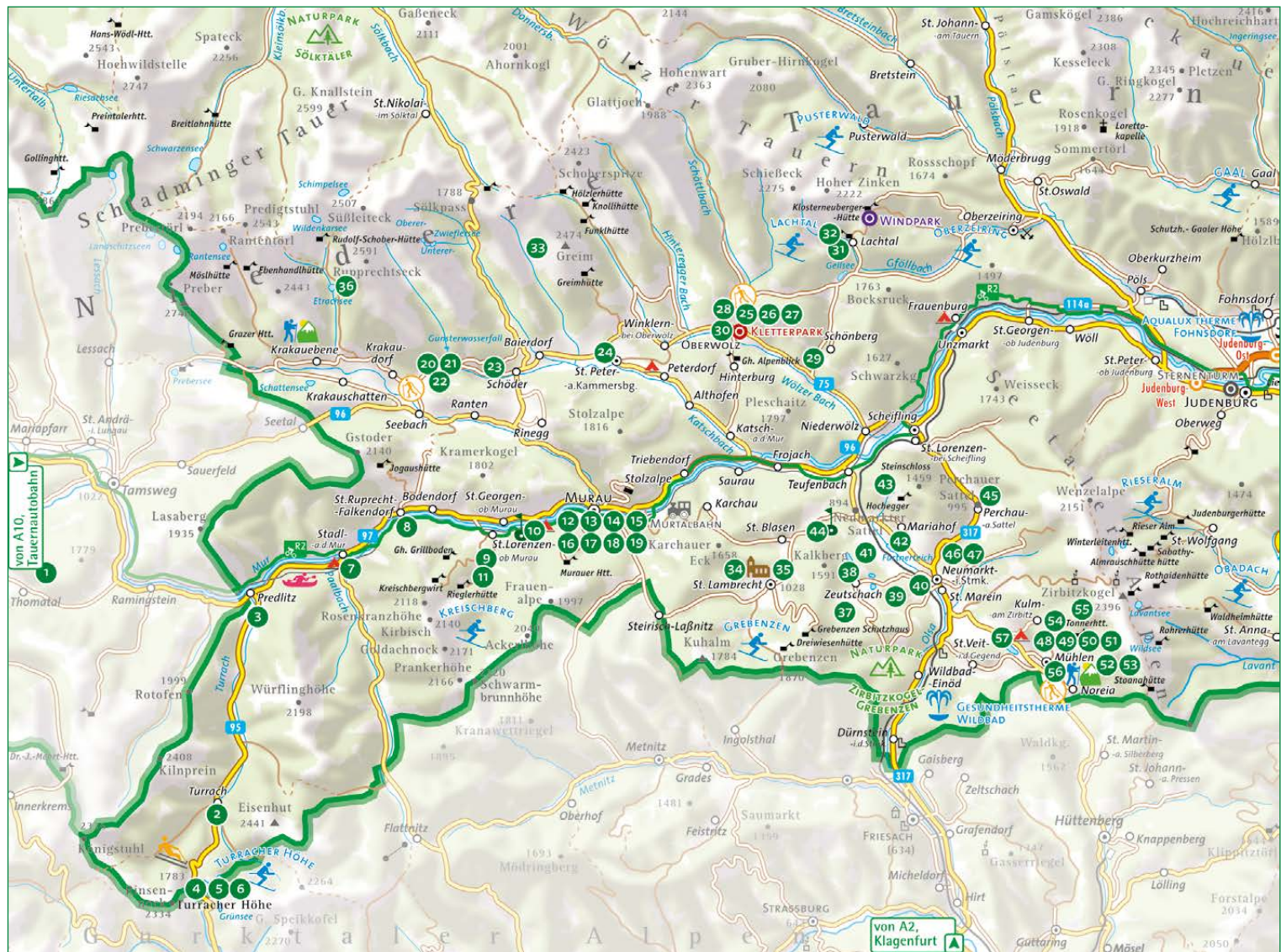

Just 300 m from the "Nocky Flitzer" toboggan run is Austria's largest gemstone and jewellery centre. Whether visiting the special exhibition, marvelling at the giant 1 m tall crystals, crafting your own jewellery or cracking precious stones, the 'Myth of the Gemstones' will leave a lasting impression. The foundation for the museum was laid in the early 1960s, which is today a unique destination in Austria for all ages. Guided tours are available every Tuesday (summer: 4 p.m., winter: 4.30 p.m.) and for groups of 8 people or more by advance booking. Children's attractions (subject to fees): digging for gemstones, cracking open geodes, mineral flea market, gold panning from 15 June to 15 September (if the weather is good).

Snorting, steaming and whistling, the steam train departs from Murau train station. The historical steam locomotives of the Murtalbahn pull carefully restored wagons through the Upper Murtal. The view from the window as you travel reveals a true picture-postcard landscape along the green river Mur. Musical entertainment and culinary treats while on board complete this railway experience. Stopping briefly in Stadl an der Mur, you can watch and take photos as the steam locomotive's water tank is filled before resuming your journey. You can also make your dream of driving a steam train come true on the Murtalbahn: if you'd like to try your hand at operating the regulators, valves, and whistle, simply sign up for an amateur locomotive trip. Trips for special occasions such as birthdays, weddings and anniversaries can be booked at any time.

Super-charge your senses and embark on an exciting journey into the world of Murau beer! Across just under 640 sqm, visitors can explore the multi-sensory world of Murau beer at the "Brauerei der Sinne" (Brewery of the Senses). An interactive tour of just under two hours includes audiovisual, olfactory and listening stations to get all five senses tingling. The brewery's jewel in the crown is its "sampling and show brewery", a kind of miniature brewery that can produce 10 hl and is used to brew creative beers such as pale ale or stout. As befits a brewery, visitors can try various specialities of Murau beer at the end of the tour. The admission price also includes a small snack and a free glass of beer.

The history of Murau goes back to the Copper Age; the oldest finds date back to 1750 BC. The minnesinger Ulrich von Liechtenstein founded the town in its present location; in 1928 Murau was awarded a town charter; the Schwarzenberg dynasty has had its seat in Murau for over 400 years through marriage to Anna Neumann. Workshops in their original condition from Murau demonstrate the creativity, technical sophistication and artistic expression of handicraft. The special exhibitions "Capuchins of Murau" and "Knitter, Tailor, Linen Weaver; Spinner and Gravedigger" tell the story of the people who used to live here, as well as the development of the region's textile sector. There is also a vivid representation of hammer mill owners, guilds, domestic economy and farming, as well as sport and trade.

The district capital of Murau is the main hub of the region. Culture lovers are delighted by the historical townscape as well as all the cultural attractions that Murau has to offer. A historical stroll through the town helps you retrace the story of the Liechtenstein and Schwarzenberg dynasties. Murau is a wonderful example of a medieval town development, and shows a successful blend of old and international award-winning architecture. Since the state exhibition "Holzzeit" (Wood Period) was held here, Murau has been Austria's wood capital and the centre of all wood-related aspects. Experience the medieval town of Murau with an audio guide. Explore the exciting history of Murau, of Anna Neumann, and of wood. Tours are available in German, English and Italian. Devices can be picked up from the Murau Information Office.

If you feel a tickle or heat, you'll realise that the stone is "alive". You'll also feel its degree of hardness, and its effects. On the lower floor is a collection of local stones, petrified wood and stones from many different countries. The fluorescent "cabinet" is fascinating, while the specialist shop displays an array of beautiful jewellery, selected stones and souvenirs. The owner is a trained healing gems consultant and leads seminars to share her knowledge.

The Krakaudorf Village Museum is housed in an old farmhouse around 400 years old: the Walzl-Haus, a former smokehouse whose origins may even go back as far as the 12th century. Everything that remains of the past has been collected here. There are no fine treasures or valuable antiques, but rather furniture, machinery, vehicles, everyday items and utensils to provide a window into what the Krakau area once looked like and how people lived. It's all brought vividly to life in several different exhibit rooms. There's an old loom your great-grandfather might have used, an oven from long ago, a small chamber for a maid and a farm boy, and a guest room from the days when tourism was a rarity. The "threshing floor" offers an overview of the countless different work tools and equipment.

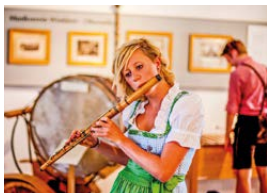
