Finally the time has come

We've waited long enough this year for spring sunshine to make us want to go on our first bike tour through the green countryside. Now it's time to "get on the saddle and start pedalling".

The cycle node system known from the Netherlands has been enjoying increasing popularity in our region for years. More than 100 orientation points have been distributed throughout the region, enabling motivated pedalers to find their way across the landscape and plan their tour individually and according to their wishes, but also to change it easily and at short notice without losing their bearings.

Getting on tour

To give busy cyclists ideas of the varied touring programme through the region, there is a touring booklet to go with the map, which is hot off the presses and has been published by the Murtal Tourist Association. 10 tour tips awaken the desire to explore and get to know the beautiful landscape on two wheels. A tour along the Mur is just as much a must as an extensive country tour in the Pölstal. On the race bike tour, racing cyclists will get their money's worth, while the thermal spa tour invites you to relax and enjoy cycling.

Steep uphill, ransanting downhill

In the new edition of the tour booklet you will find for the first time a selection of the most exciting MTB tours from Hohentauern via Kleinlobming to St. Marein near Knittelfeld, because in the Murtal you don't just have to enjoy the cycling routes along the green meadows of the Mur and slow down. Murtal also stands for acceleration, here crisp climbs as well as adrenaline-fuelled descents let you feel the heartbeat all along the line. In addition, the new tour booklet contains information about the MTB trails of the region, where MTB fans can really step on the gas and take off.
